Code of Conduct

In order to be a member of a Unity Concord International School team, you must conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner at all times. You must abide by the policies and conditions described in the UCIS Parent/Student Handbook and adhere to team rules and decisions made by the coach(es). Specifically, you must adhere to the following:

1. Maintain a minimum of 2.0 in all academic areas.
2. Attend practices, meetings, contests and award ceremonies.
3. Always support and show respect towards your team members or opponents.
4. Respect the authority of your coach.
5. Display good sportsmanship; this includes NO abusive or profane language in any setting.
6. Refrain from the use and possession of tobacco, alcohol and/or drugs.
7. Demonstrate a winning and productive attitude.
8. Understand that you represent yourself and your school when participating.

Risk Statement

By their very nature, athletic activities can put students in situations in which serious injuries may occur.

Students and parents must assess the risks involved in such participation and make their choice to participate in spite of those risks. No amount of instruction, precaution or supervision will eliminate all risk of injury, but UCIS staff will do their very best to ensure the safety of all athletes. By granting permission for your son/daughter to participate in athletic activities, you, the parent/legal guardian, acknowledge that such risk exists.

All participants in this activity should understand that participation is voluntary and is not required by the school.
